



ROTARY WHEELS

The Rotary Wheels Program is a local homegrown demand-response transportation service, which is not held to any particular schedule, that operates Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Riders call 24 hours in advance to schedule their pickup times and the routes and schedules are based on those requests.

The service operates only within O'Fallon Township and the O'Fallon city limits but once a week a trip to St. Clair Square is scheduled.

The van is equipped with a wheelchair lift and the service is provided at no cost for Senior citizens and the Disabled. The cost is \$1.00 each way for all other passengers.

The Rotary Wheels program has served our community for more than two decades, starting in 1981 and has existed due to a combined effort of our Rotary Club, O'Fallon Township and Road District, the City of O'Fallon, the Chamber of Commerce and a variety of advertisers and volunteers.

Rotarians serving on The Rotary Wheels Committee are Chairman Dave Witter and Ken Diel, who were instrumental in starting the service. At the time of founding the service, Dave Witter served as President of our Rotary Club and Ken Diel served as President of the O'Fallon Chamber.
